Free dumping privileges of non-industrial and non-commercial refuse at Newby Island every 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month; visits limited to six times per year (one visit per Milpitas utility bill) with two proofs of Milpitas residency required (drivers license with Milpitas address/last and the most recent City of Milpitas utility bill stub); trucks with up to 4 cubic yards of refuse and up to one ton payload accepted.

- **COMMERCIAL FRANCHISE AGREEMENT**

Milpitas has an agreement with Allied Waste Services, which includes a commercial recycling program of commingled recyclables. An independent recycling provider may collect recyclables in Milpitas, but Milpitas Municipal Code requirements and franchise agreement stipulations apply. Specifically, an independent recycler shall:

- Maintain a valid business license with the City of Milpitas
- Maintain a separate franchise agreement with the City of Milpitas (to pay 12% franchise fees on a quarterly basis)
- Provide a report of the types and quantities of recyclables hauled from Milpitas businesses
- Ensure that there is no net cost to Milpitas businesses for the recycling service;
- Collect only these franchise-excepted materials: cardboard, mixed paper, scrap metal, polystyrene, clean wood, pallets, circuit boards

Maintain that excepted materials are source separated by the generator prior to collection and contain no residue (garbage or other recyclable material).

- **DEBRIS BOX INFORMATION**

Residents and businesses of Milpitas may use any commercial debris box service.

MFD: Recycling collection is weekly on the same day as garbage collection

³ Late Utility Payment Penalties

* All accounts are due and payable within forty-five (45) days of the date of the bill. Accounts shall become delinquent and a late fee of five percent of the amount due shall be imposed if payment has been received by 5:00pm on the due date. Prior to discontinuing service for delinquent accounts, a final notice shall be issued to the delinquent account stating that payment shall be due within fifteen (15) days of the date of the final notice and that service may be terminated after sixteen (16) days of the final notice if payment is not received. If payment has not been received by 5:00pm of the due date of the final notice, an additional late fee equal to five percent of the amount then due shall be imposed.
