³ Late Utility Payment Penalties

- * All accounts are due and payable within forty-five (45) days of the date of the bill. Accounts shall become delinquent and a late fee of five percent of the amount due shall be imposed if payment has been received by 5:00pm on the due date. Prior to discontinuing service for delinquent accounts, a final notice shall be issued to the delinquent account stating that payment shall be due within fifteen (15) days of the date of the final notice and that service may be terminated after sixteen (16) days of the final notice if payment is not received. If payment has not been received by 5:00pm of the due date of the final notice, an additional late fee equal to five percent of the amount then due shall be imposed.

COMMERCIAL RECYCLING FRANCHISE AGREEMENT INFORMATION

The City of Milpitas has an agreement with Browning-Ferris Industries (BFI), which includes a commercial recycling program of commingled recyclables. An independent recycling provider may collect recyclables, but may not charge a fee. Milpitas requires a report of the types and quantities of recyclables a provider, other than the franchised hauler, picks up. The City must permit independent recyclers.
