Cardboard	X		Corrugated cardboard and cereal boxes; Bundled flat 2'x2'x2'.
Glass	X		Bottles and jars; rinse and place in recycling bin; labels OK.
Household Batteries	X		Place in clear plastic bag, and on your recycling cart.

Yard Trimmings	X		Residents are provided a green 95-gallon wheeled cart for yard trimmings collection. Yard trimmings collection is weekly with the recycling and garbage collection.
