<b>Aseptic Containers</b>	X		Juice boxes accepted.
<b>Bulk Item Pick-Up</b>	X		\$30.00 for each item. No hazardous material accepted.
<b>Batteries</b>	X		Household batteries only.
<b>Cans</b>	X		Aluminum, steel, tin and bi-metal cans accepted.
<b>Cardboard</b>	X		
<b>Glass</b>	X		All colors of glass bottles and jars.
<b>Household Batteries</b>	X		Place in clear plastic bag and next to trash can
<b>Magazines</b>	X		Place in bin.
<b>Metals, Other</b>	X		Small appliances (under 35 lbs.); small metal car parts, clean and drained of oil and fluids (under 40 lbs.); and scrap aluminum foil and pans; and empty aerosol cans.
<b>Metals, Scrap</b>	X		Scrap metal under 40 lbs.
<b>Mixed Paper</b>	X		Includes junk mail, paperboard, catalogs, magazines, envelopes, brown craft paper, and phone books.
<b>Newspaper</b>	X		Newspapers and newspaper inserts.

<b>Trees</b>	X		Flocked and natural holiday trees are accepted that are cut to 4 foot lengths.
<b>Wood</b>	X		Clean, unpainted, untreated; wood must fit into 32 gallon can, wood can be no longer than 24 inches, may be mixed with yard waste.
