<b>Aseptic Containers</b>	X		Milk cartons and juice boxes accepted; place in mixed container bin.
<b>Aerosol Cans</b>	X		Place in mixed container bin.
<b>Bulk Item Pick-Up</b>	X		\$40.00 for first two items and \$20.00 for each additional item. An additional \$50.00 fee for each hazardous item.
<b>Cans</b>	X		Aluminum, steel, and bi-metal cans
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>	X		Cut into 3' x 3' pieces -place inside recycle cart or lay flat next to cart.
<b>Glass</b>	X		Jars and bottles, all colors.
<b>Household Batteries</b>	X		Place in clear plastic bag and on the recycling cart
<b>Metals, Other</b>	X		Scrap aluminum foil and pans, scrap metal under 40 lbs., small kitchen appliances under 30 lbs. (i.e., toasters), Small metal car parts, clean and drained of oil and fluids.
<b>Mixed Paper</b>	X		Magazines, junk mail, paperboard, envelopes, brown craft paper bags, phone books.
<b>Newspaper</b>	X		
<b>Oil</b>	X		Limit 2 gallons per week, call for free oil jugs.
<b>Oil Filters</b>	X		Special collection bag required, call to request. Drain filter for 24 hours after removal from car; seal in bag, set on newspaper at curbside.
<b>Plastic (#1-#7)</b>	X		Jars, tubs, containers, lids. Plastics must be marked #1-#7.
<b>Textiles and Leathers</b>		X	
<b>Yard Trimmings</b>	X		Place out in Yard Trimmings cart only. Cannot be placed loose on the street.
